This program is specifically for children demonstrating a medical or behavioral condition where a constant line of sight supervision is needed to keep the child and others safe.

### Age

Under 18 years old

# Daily Living

Needs support with some or all activities of daily living

### **Supervision**

Requires constant line of sight supervision to maintain safety

### Residence

Lives in the family home

### **Determination**

Determined to have a developmental disability or delay (if under 5)

### **Financial**

Long-Term Care Medicaid Criteria Meets Social Security Disability definition & financial requirements for Health First Colorado Medicaid
