CHILDREN'S EXTENSIVE SERVICES WAIVER (CES)



What is it?

The Children's Extensive Support (CES) Waiver helps children under 18 and families by providing services to assist children in establishing a long-term foundation for community inclusion as they grow into adulthood. This program is specifically for children demonstrating a medical or behavioral condition where a constant line of sight supervision is needed to keep the child and others safe.

Am I eligible?

Age

Under 18 years old

Daily Living

Needs support with some or all activities of daily living

Supervision

Requires constant line of sight supervision to maintain safety

Residence

Lives in the family home

Determination

Determined to have a developmental disability or delay (if under 5)

Financial

Long-Term Care Medicaid Criteria
Meets Social Security Disability definition & financial requirements for Health First Colorado Medicaid
