PLAN FOR FY20

Accessing Funds

- Enrolled families can access the Direct Services funds
 (payment directly to family or pay provider). Emergency funds
 are available to both active FSSP families and those eligible for
 FSSP and can be accessed once per fiscal year. Amount of
 funds received through Direct Service and Emergency funds
 are based on MIN scores as follows:
 - Low MIN (0-19): \$3,000
 - Medium MIN (20-39): \$4,000
 - High MIN (40+): \$5,000
- Funds to be used towards FSSP Direct Service funds & FSSP Emergency Funds: \$734,777.02
- Funds to be used towards FSSP Program Expense (supports for multiple families both Active FSSP and Wait List): \$400,000



PROGRAM EXPENSE

A total of 254 Active FSSP individuals, 747 individuals eligible for FSSP utilized services under Program Expense for FY19. Some of these numbers are duplicated as the same individuals could have participated in multiple events throughout the year. Program Expenses Explained

- Families who utilize our **Parent's Night Out events** (3 hours of free respite care) were able to receive a break from caregiving to relax and rejuvenate. These parents return refreshed and better able to care for their child/children.
- Families benefit from an **enhanced level of case coordination** by receiving hands on support and resource navigation from our Resource Navigator position.
- Families receive help completing applications and are provided trainings on Medicaid and Private insurance.
- Additionally, throughout the year, various trainings and recreational offerings are also available to families.
